A Fine Late 18th Century Italian Walnut and Parcel Gilt Dining Table No. 4782

A Fine Late 18th Century Italian Walnut and Parcel Gilt Dining Table with six leaves, the top adorned with a gilded foliate border, the whole raised on six tapering legs accented by gilded acanthus leaf collars (leaves are later)

An Exceptional Late 18th Century Venetian Chinoiserie Marble Chess Set in Original Box No.4780

An Exceptional Late 18th Century Venetian Chinoiserie Marble Chess Set in Original Box, with whimsical Chinoiserie scenes and ornate geometric patterns on an umber ground, the whole set on an elegant later stand terminating in scrolled feet joined by a serpentine x-stretcher

A 19th Century Italian Giltwood Console Table No. 4760

A 19th Century Italian Giltwood Console Table with a white carrera marble top, the apron centered with a dramatic and stunning carved shell motif, and above four shaped carved cabriole legs accented with various rocaille and foliage motifs, all connected by a scrolling rocaille x-shaped stretcher with a shell at its center, flanked by roses, various flowers and foliate carvings

A Harlequin Pair of 19th Century Italian Walnut Credenzini No. 4756

A Harlequin Pair of 19th Century Italian Walnut Credenzini in the Renaissance Revival Style, each with a later top above a denticulated frieze, one with an intricately carved apron, both with a single drawer over two interior compartments, making for a total of four doors per credenzina, flanked by embellished wood carvings of soldiers and dancers, each credenzina with (1) key

A 17th Century Italian Walnut Refectory Table No. 4758

A 17th Century Italian Walnut Refectory Table, with three drawers accented with detailed carvings, and geometric carvings throughout, the whole raised on four uniquely shaped and carved bulbous legs connected by an H-shaped stretcher

An Exceptional 18th Century English George III Console

Table No. 4740

An Exceptional 18th Century English George III Burl Maple and Giltwood Console Table, the marquetry burl maple top above a carved gilded frieze adorned with alternating floral motifs, the whole raised on six squared tapering giltwood legs

An Unusual Early 18th Century Queen Anne Heavily Patinated Mahogany Envelope Table No. 4697

An Unusual Early 18th Century Queen Anne Heavily Patinated Mahogany Envelope Table, raised on four tapering turned legs and terminating in pad feet

A 19th Century English Walnut Octagonal Partner's Desk No. 4710

A 19th century English Walnut Octagonal Partners Desk, the embossed leather top with a conforming walnut parquetry border, with slides on each side revealing additional embossed leather writing surfaces, with 8 functional drawers on one

side and the opposite side with 2 cabinet doors disguised as drawers, comes with 4 keys

A 19th Century English Regency Rosewood Folding Games Table No. 4715

A 19th Century English Regency Rosewood Folding Games Table with brass inlay, the folding top opens to reveal an embossed C. Mariani antiqued leather playing surface, the whole raised on a lyre pedestal base with four saber legs terminating in lion paw sabots and casters

A Pair of 19th Century French Ormolu Gueridons No. 4722

A Pair of 19th Century French Ormolu Gueridons with Black Marble Tops and conforming undertiers all raised on three incurved legs joined by tripartite stretchers and centered by a flame urn finial and terminating in conforming lion paw feet

A Late 18th c. Louis XVI Italian Egyptian Revival Gilded Center Table No. 4733

A Late 18th century Louis XVI Italian Egyptian Revival Gilded Center Table with a variegated green and cream breccia marble top raised on an inverse fluted pedestal resting on a tripartite base adorned with three well carved and gilded sphinxes

An 18th Century Italian Parcel-Gilt Walnut Expanding Dining Table No. 4709

An 18th Century Italian Parcel-Gilt Walnut Expanding Dining Table with five 20-inch leaves (pictured with four), the top with a burl walnut border, the apron with gilded gadrooning, and the whole raised on five turned tapering legs accented with gilded acanthus leaf collars at the knees and terminating in brass casters

A 19th Century English

Regency Mahogany Sofa Table No. 4705

A 19th Century English Regency Mahogany Sofa Table, the top with a rosewood and brass stellate inlay border, above two drop leaves on either side, an apron fitted with two functioning drawers and two faux drawers on the reverse, raised on lyre legs connected with a turned h-shaped stretcher, and raised on splayed legs terminating in lion paw sabots and casters

A 19th Century English Regency Chinese Export Black Lacquer and Parcel-Gilt Chinoiserie Tea Table No. 4699

A 19th Century English Regency Chinese Export Black Lacquer and Parcel-Gilt Chinoiserie Tea Table, with intricately depicted scenes of mandarins drinking tea and socializing, with various floral and foliate motifs throughout, the whole raised on a tripartite pedestal base with lion paw feet

An 18th Century English Queen Anne Elmwood and Burl Elmwood Lowboy No. 4698

An 18th Century English Queen Anne Elmwood and Burl Elmwood Lowboy, the top centered with an intricate patchwork veneered burlwood pattern (always a sign of quality) with one drawer above a scalloped arching apron and raised on four unusual shaped legs

A 19th Century English Burl Walnut Games Table No. 4702

A 19th Century English Burl Walnut Games Table, the top with lobed corners and a raised gallery edge and inset with with C. Mariani hand-dyed and embossed leather, the apron with two drawers and carved gadroon detailing along lower edge, with the whole raised on four cabriole legs with acanthus-carved knees and terminating in ball and claw feet

A 19th Century English Mahogany Expanding Dining

Table No. 4315

A 19th Century English Mahogany Expanding Dining Table, with three leaves, embellished with foliate carvings along the edges and terminating in padded feet

A 19th Century English Regency Burl Elmwood and Parcel-Gilt Partners Desk No. 4689

A 19th Century English Regency Burl Elmwood and Parcel-Gilt Partners Desk, the later C. Mariani embossed leather writing surface above six functioning drawers with keys (3 on each side), and raised on splayed legs terminating in brass casters and connected by a turned stretcher with giltwood accents

An 18th Century French Louis XV Polychrome Rafrachissoir No. 4667

An 18th Century French Louis XV Polychrome Rafrachissoir, the shaped inset faux marble painted top with two removable tin lined coolers for chilling wine, and with one drawer for

napkins and serving utensils, with the whole raised on cabriole legs terminating in pied de biche feet

A Remarkable 18th Century English Burl Walnut Games Table No. 4692

A Remarkable 18th Century English Burl Walnut Games Table, the top displaying a quartered and butterflied veneered surface to create an unusual, rare and stunning pattern, accented with lobed corners (originally for candlesticks to light the table) and bordered in a raised edge above a shaped apron fitted with one drawer, and with the whole raised on four cabriole legs embellished with giltwood acanthus carvings and terminating in pad feet

An Unusual Pair of 18th Century Italian Walnut Candle Stands or Side Tables No. 4687

An Unusual Pair of 18th Century Italian Walnut Candle Stands or Side Tables, with a bulbous baluster shaped pedestal and a tripartite base

A Pair of 17th Century Tuscan Walnut Lyre-Legged Trestle Console Tables No. 4663

A Pair of 17th Century Tuscan Walnut Lyre-Legged Trestle Console Tables, retaining their original lustrous patina, with the hexagonal tops; the two tables can be used together as an octagonal center table

A Handsome 17th Century Tuscan Walnut Trestle Table No. 4660

A Handsome 17th Century Tuscan Walnut Trestle Table with scrolling legs and conforming harp stretchers

A Remarkable 18th Century Italian Rosewood, Ebony,

Etched Bone and Palisander Inlaid Marquetry Table No. 4659

A Remarkable 18th Century Italian Rosewood, Ebony, Etched Bone and Palisander Inlaid Marquetry Table, with intricate floral motifs and filigree patterns covering the top and continuing along the apron, fitted with a functioning drawer at each end, the whole raised on cabriole legs terminating in giltwood ball and claw feet

A Diminutive 19th Century Chinoiserie Black Lacquered Panel No. 4655

A Diminutive 19th Century Chinoiserie Black Lacquered Panel, now serving as the top of a coffee table, with two figures in a village scene surrounded by birds and trees, with the whole raised on an elaborately chased brass cast base in a tendril motif
